SUBJECT: 2017 GREAT TEACHER NOMINATIONS

The University of Kentucky Alumni Association annually recognizes outstanding members of the UK faculty for their superior classroom and teaching skills, their concern for students, and their involvement in the academic community. These awards, first presented in 1961, are highly prized. Each recipient receives a \$3,000 award.

If you are president of a campus organization, we urge you to announce this nomination to your members. Nominations may be made by organizations or individuals. All currently enrolled UK students are encouraged to nominate a teacher who truly merits consideration for the award. To be eligible, a nominee must hold the rank of full-time lecturer or above and have been a member of the UK faculty for the past three years. Winners of the award since 2006 may not be nominated for this year's award. Their names are noted by an asterisk on the enclosed list of past recipients.

There are many traits that distinguish good teaching from ordinary instruction. Some of these traits are superior knowledge of the subject matter, fresh and stimulating classroom lectures or effective discussion, and demonstrated concern for the students and student activities. Nomination essays must be detailed to give specific information that will clearly represent the nominee's traits to the selection committee. The selection committee relies totally upon your description to make their decision.

If the teacher that you have nominated is awarded this prestigious award then the nominator will be invited to attend the dinner where he/she is recognized.

Every year the University of Kentucky Alumni Association recognizes a select group of outstanding teachers and honors them with a \$3,000 award at a luncheon or dinner. There have been 277 teachers honored since 1961. Recipients are selected by a special committee appointed by the UK Alumni Association Board of Directors. Please consider the following criteria when nominating someone for the Great Teacher Award.

Candidate Must:

- 1. Hold the rank of full-time lecturer or above and have been a member of the UK faculty for the past three years.
- 2. Have superior knowledge of subject matter.
- 3. Have original and innovative teaching methods.
- 4. Demonstrate concern for students, both inside and outside the university setting.
- 5. Not have been a recipient of this award since 2006. (A list of recipients from 1961-2016 has been attached to this nomination form. The professors marked with an asterisk have received this award within the past 10 years and are not eligible.)

Application Instructions and Deadline:

- You must be a currently enrolled UK student to submit a nomination.
- Please complete the items listed on the following page in narrative form. An attachment providing additional information (limited to two pages) about the nominee is acceptable. Articulate nomination essays that clearly present the nominee's traits will be especially appreciated by the selection committee.
