The theme of the 2007 meeting is "Winning the Energy Trifecta" which reflects the challenges we face exploring for, developing, and utilizing energy resources in an environmentally-sustainable way. Kentucky's central location and scenic geology provide a perfect setting for discussing energy issues in the Appalachian, Illinois, and Michigan Basins.
