The Creation of Mental Health Challenge Coins to Acknowledge Mental Health Concerns Among Today's Agricultural Youth: An Innovative Idea

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INTRODUCTION

- Mental Health is a growing concern within the agriculture industry (CDC, 2020).
- In 2020, the suicide rate was 14.2% between the ages of 15 and 24 (CDC, 2022).
- The branches of the military use a *Challenge Coin* to recognize their soldiers and show their appreciation.
- Many organizations have adopted the concept.

OBJECTIVE

- Create opportunities for individuals to begin difficult conversations on mental health.
- Extend the Agriculture Mental Health
 Challenge Coin into High Schools and
 Organizations.

METHODOLOGY

- Kentucky has created their own Challenge
 Coin- an Agriculture Mental Health Challenge
 Coin
- Front of the coin is stamped with the organization, back of the coin has the suicide hotline.
- The purpose of the coin to express your appreciation for the recipient.
- Without a handshake and a face-to-face conversation, the challenge is not complete

COST

- Each coin costs between \$3-\$5.
- The gatekeeper training is \$249 per person.





RESULTS TO DATE

- Approximately 6,950 Challenge Coins has been printed.
- Approximately 50% of the Challenge
 Coins has been passed out.

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
