GIFTS AND PLEDGES TO ZANTKER PROFESSORSHIP IN JUDAIC STUDIES

<u>Recommendation</u>: that the Board of Trustees accept gifts of \$19,650 and pledges of \$53,700 from 11 donors to the Zantker Professorship in Judaic Studies in the College of Arts and Sciences.

<u>Background</u>: The Zantker Charitable Foundation and Jewish leaders in Lexington have been raising funds for the Zantker Professorship in Judaic Studies with a goal of reaching \$1,000,000, the amount required to fund a chair. This \$73,350, when matched by the state's Research Challenge Trust Fund, will bring the total gifts and pledges to the professorship to \$946,700.

The gifts and pledges being accepted today include: a pledge of \$10,000 from Mr. Alan F. Bloomfield; a gift of \$1,000 and a pledge of \$5,000 from Mr. Harold J. and Anita R. Baker; a pledge of \$10,000 from Mr. Steve Caller; a gift of \$50 from Dr. Larry H. Kagan of Virginia Beach, Virginia; a gift of \$5,000 and a pledge of \$5,000 from Mr. Erle L. and Sara A. Levy; a gift of \$100 and a pledge of \$200 from Dr. Lloyd D. Mayer; a gift of \$1,000 from Mr. Joseph H. Miller; a gift of \$500 from Dr. Richard L. Munich of Lawrence, Kansas; a gift of \$500 from Dr. Harriett A. Rose; a gift of \$2,500 and a pledge of \$7,500 from the Rosenstein Family Charitable Foundation, Inc.; and a gift of \$9,000 and a pledge of \$16,000 from Mr. Warren W. Rosenthal. All of the pledges will be paid within five years. The donors are from Lexington unless otherwise noted.
