The Academic Affairs Committee of the Board of Trustees met in Room A, 18<sup>th</sup> Floor Patterson Office Tower at 10:30 a.m. on October 25, 2005. Myra Tobin, Chair of the Academic Affairs Committee, called the meeting to order. The following members of the Committee were in attendance: Roy Moore, Barbara Young and Penny Brown.

Ms. Tobin distributed the minutes of the June 14, 2005 meeting and asked for any corrections or additions. There being no changes, a motion was made by Barbara Young to accept the minutes as distributed. The motion was unanimously approved.

AACR 1: Change of Name of a Degree Master of Science in Family Studies with a Major in Family Studies – Resolution requesting approval of a change in the name of the College of Agriculture's Master of Science in Family Studies with a major in Home Economics to Master of Science in Family Studies with a major in Family Studies, effective in the fall 2005 semester. A motion was made by Barbara Young to approve the recommendation. After a brief discussion of the background, the motion was unanimously approved.
