

## **Specialty Board Certification**


Aggregate residency and fellowship specialty board certification rates continue to exceed ACGME benchmarks

47% of residents and fellows going into practice stayed in Kentucky






### ACGME Accredited Program Growth





### **ACGME Sponsoring Institution Size**






