COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE, FOOD, AND ENVIRONMENT

Recommendation: that the Board of Trustees approve the suspension of admissions and closure of the Doctor of Philosophy in Crop Science, within the College of Agriculture, Food, and Environment, effective in the Fall 2020 semester.

Background: This program was replaced with an interdisciplinary program in Integrated Plant and Soil Sciences in 2011. There are no current students in the major and as such the deletion will not affect any faculty, staff, or students.
