ACADEMIC DEGREE: COLLEGE OF PHARMACY

<u>Recommendation</u>: that the Board of Trustees approve the establishment of a Bachelor of Science degree with a major in Pharmaceutical Sciences, in the Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences, within the College of Pharmacy.

Background: The proposed degree in Pharmaceutical Sciences will encompass a broad array of sub-disciplines all grounded in the application of the basic sciences to the discovery of new drugs, the development of novel drug delivery products, and/or the commercialization of medicinals. While a four-year degree in pharmaceutical sciences establishes a strong foundation for those planning to become pharmacists, it is much more than a "pre-pharmacy" degree path. It will prepare students to directly engage in the research, application, production, and/or commercialization of new pharmacological employment therapeutics prepare students for immediate and in the pharmaceutical/clinical research industry, graduate school or advanced training in a health profession.

This proposal has the approval of the College of Pharmacy and the Provisional Faculty Senate Executive Committee. The Provost of the University supports this recommendation.
