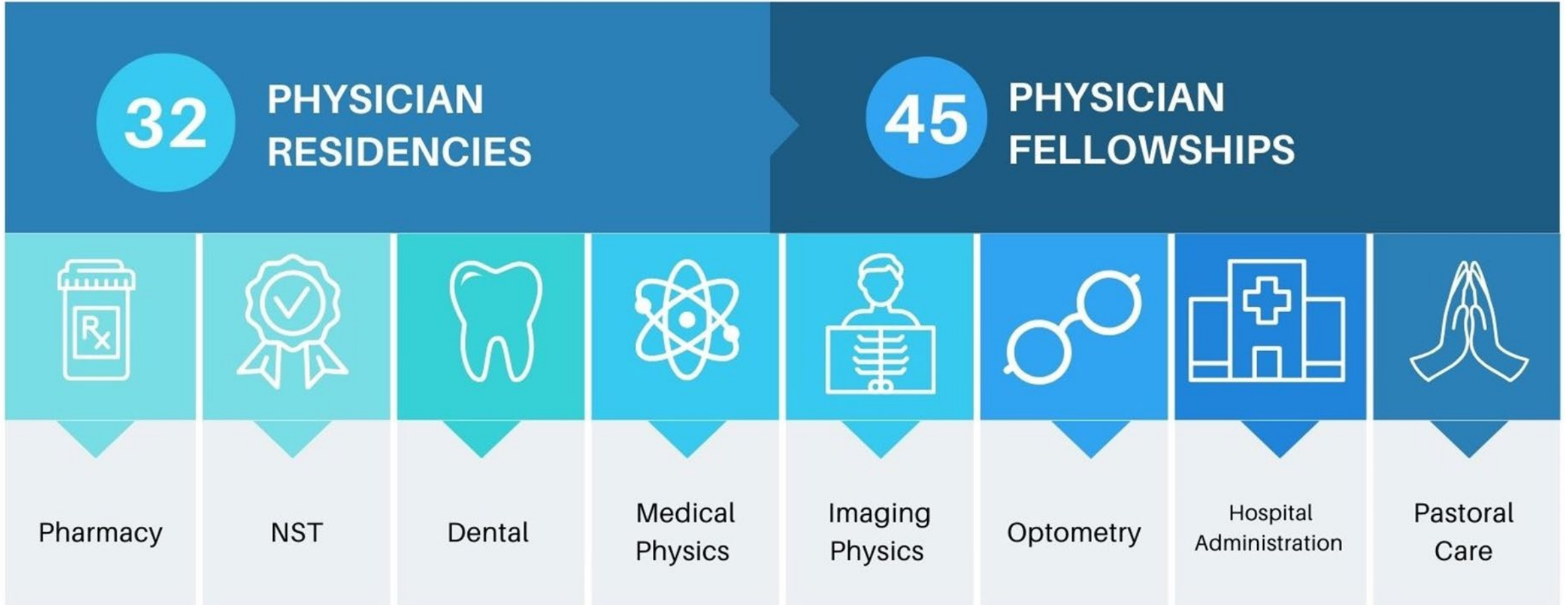

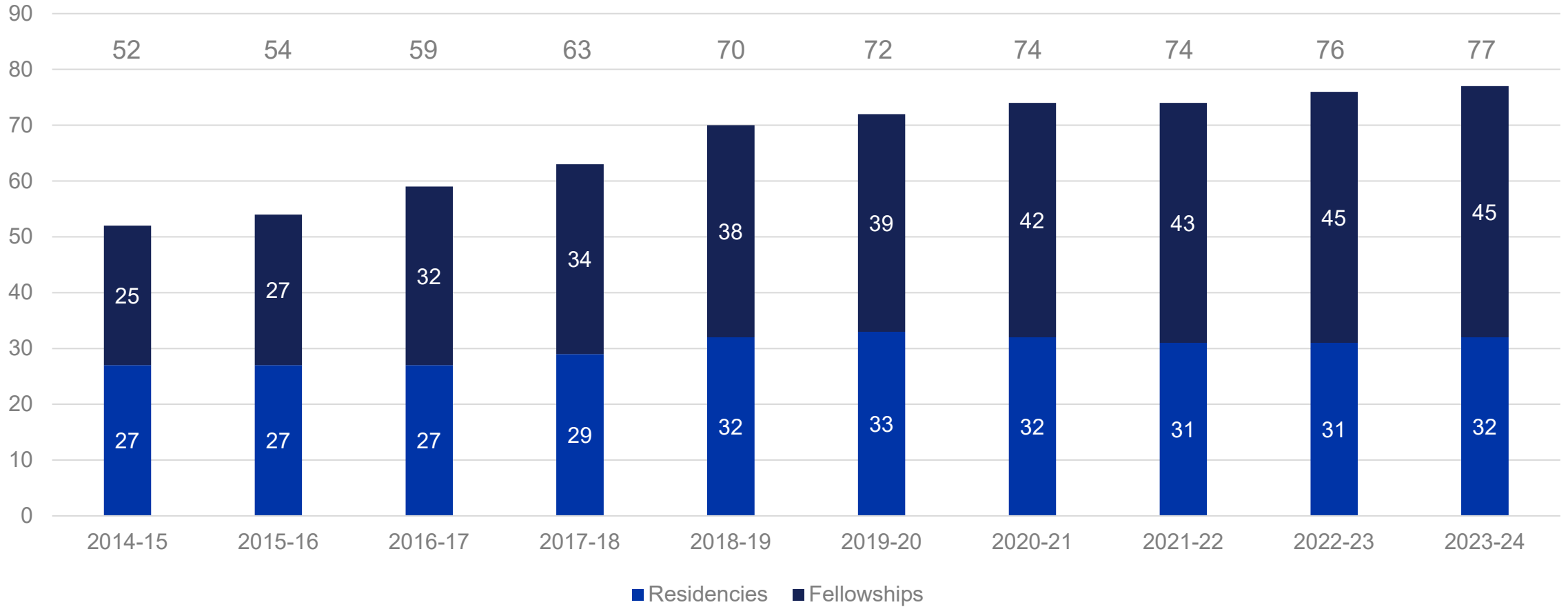

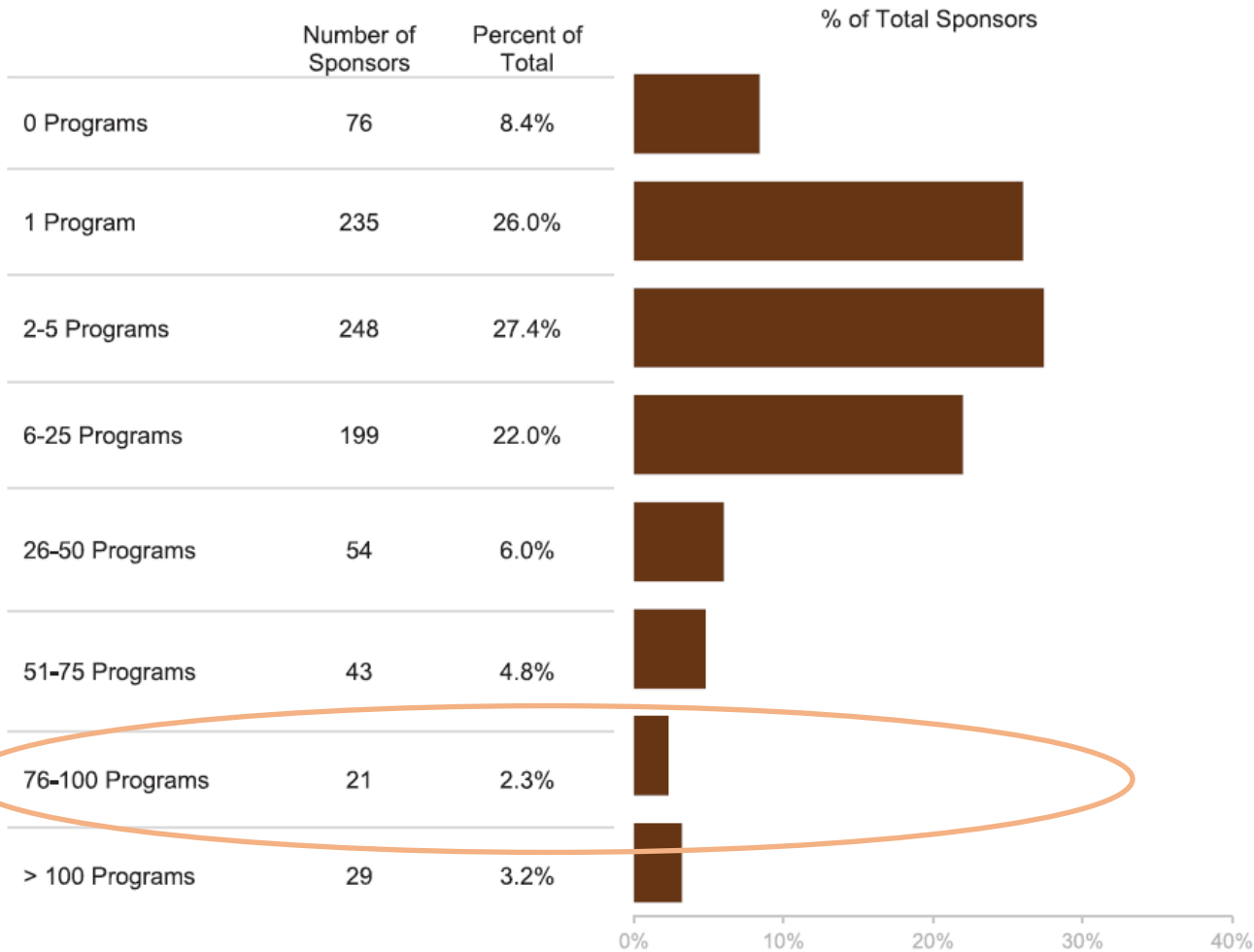

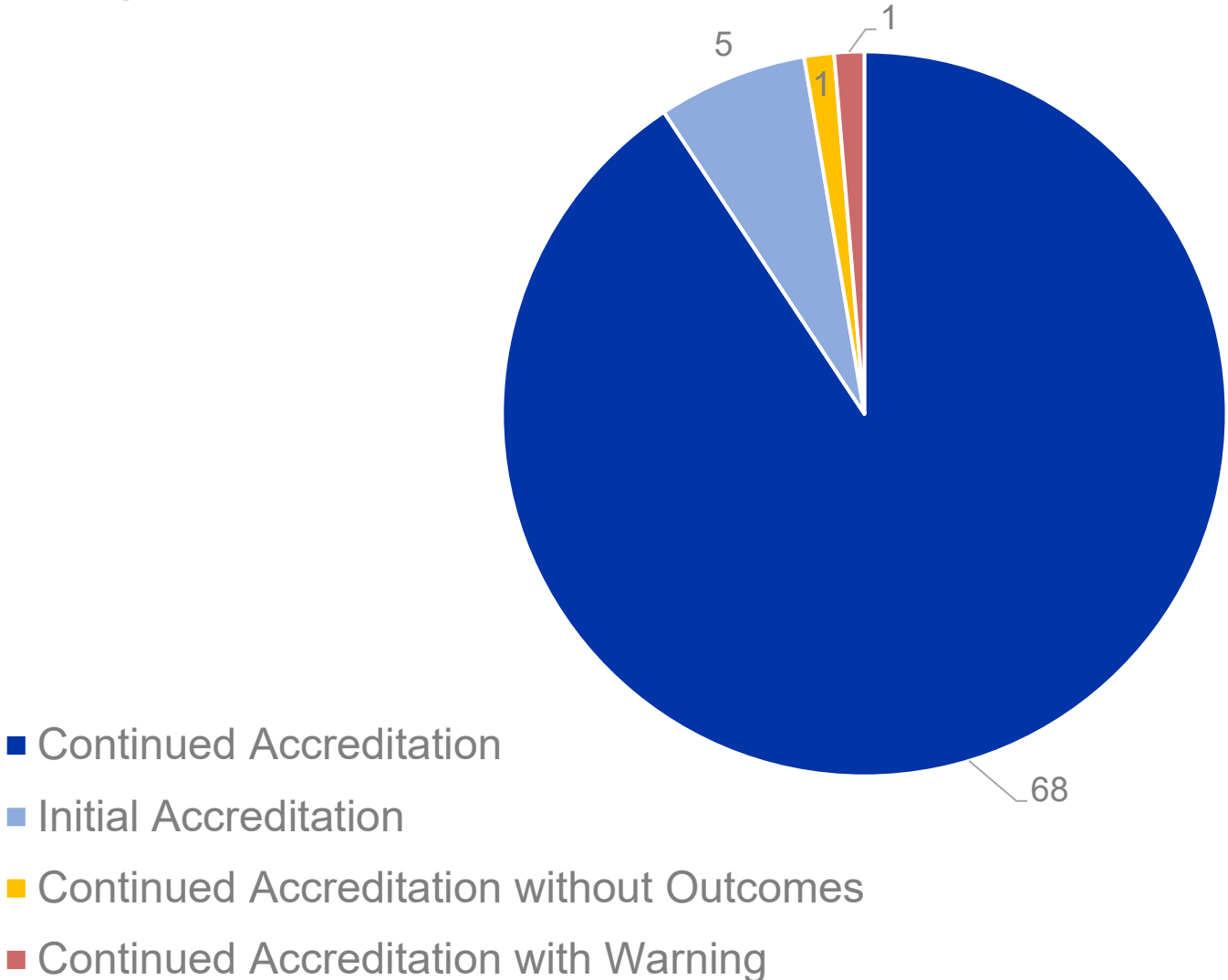

2023-24 ACGME ACCREDITATION OUTCOMES

ACGME Institutional Accreditation Status

- One of eight ACGME sponsoring institutions in Kentucky.
- 10-year site visit occurred on Jan. 25, 2024.
- Continued accreditation with substantial compliance.
- Nonstandard training initial recognition status effective July 1, 2023.

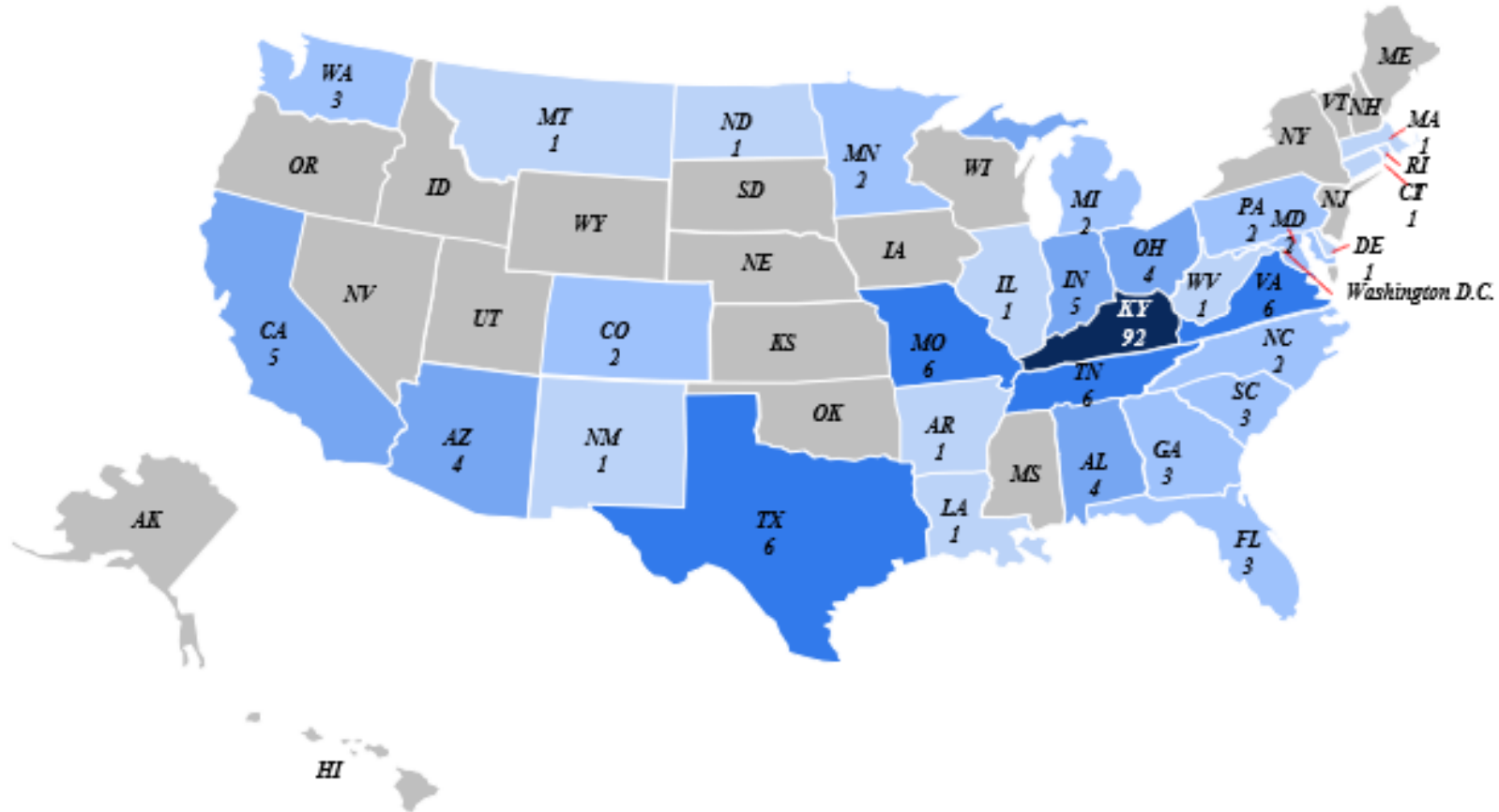

2024 Physician Graduate Practice Location

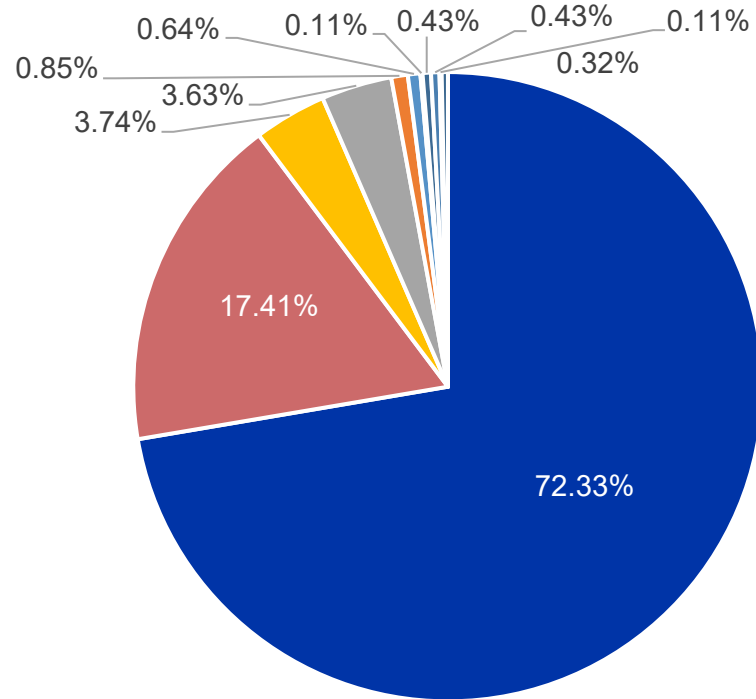
51% of residents and fellows going into practice stayed in Kentucky.



*182 physician graduates reported going into practice in 2024 — excludes 64 graduates continuing in GME training at another institution and seven graduates with unreported future plans.

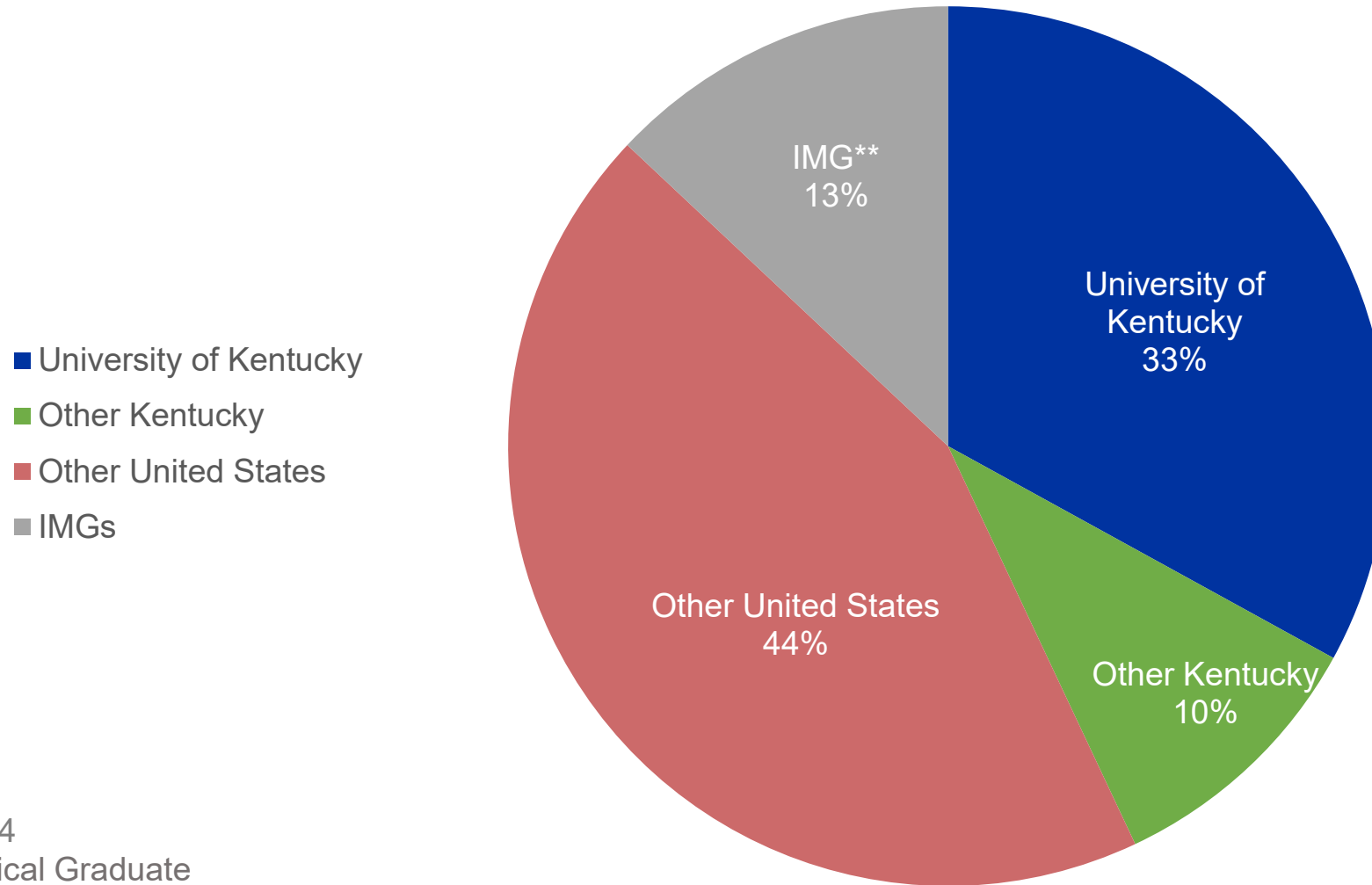

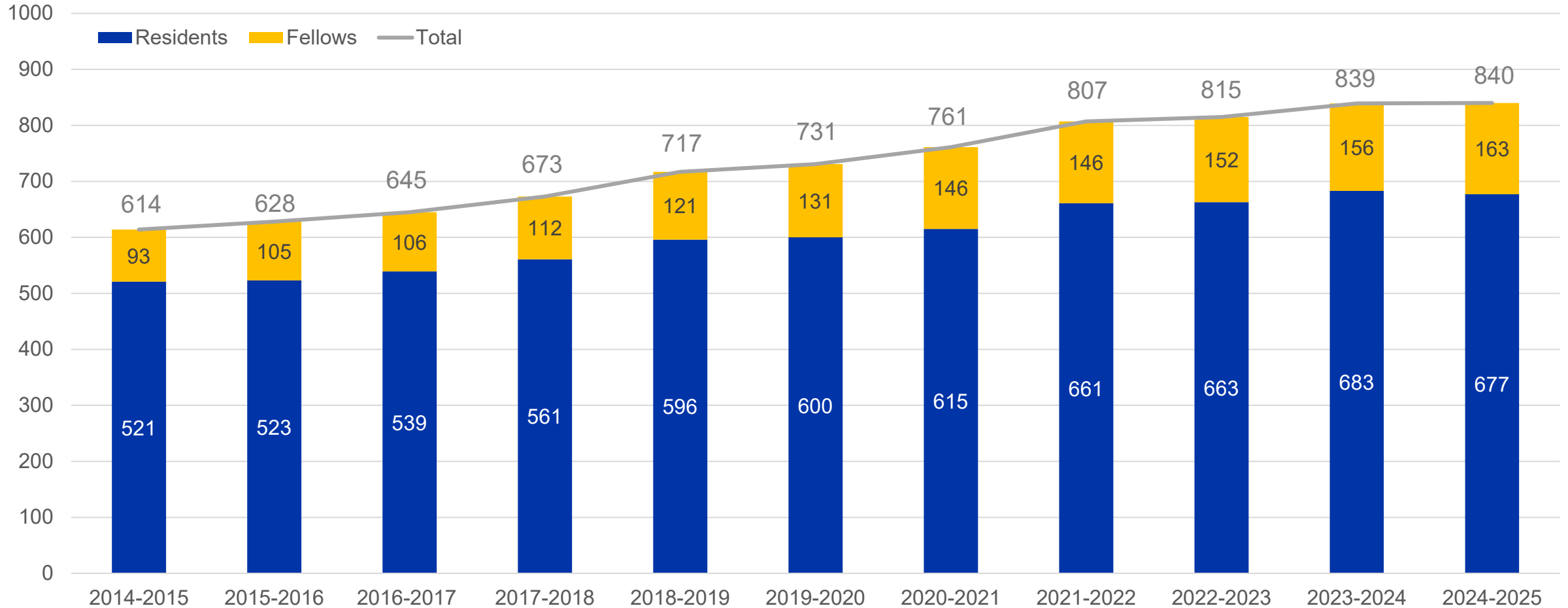
Incoming Intern Medical School Training Locations

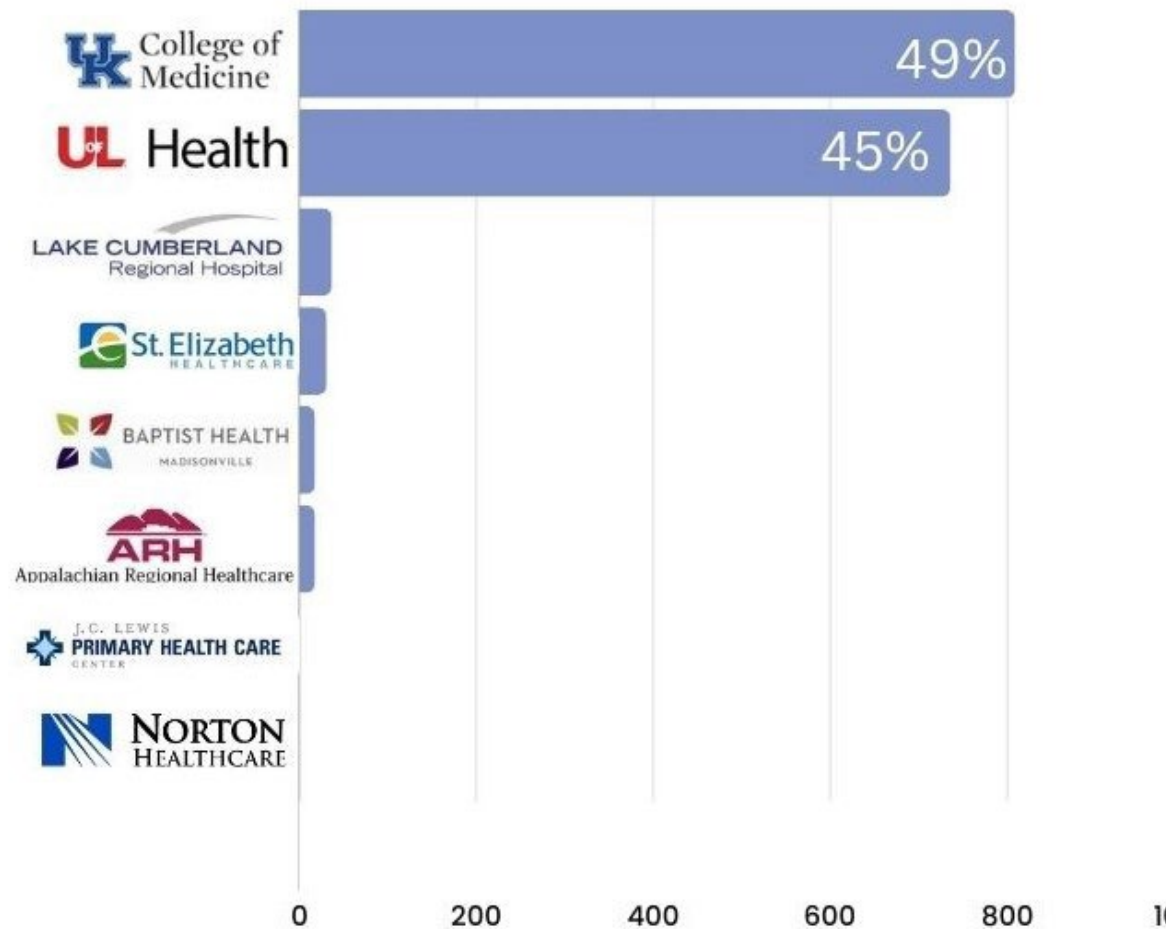
Growing the Annual Number of Residents and Fellows
