NAMING OF THE WINSLOW STREET MULTI-USE BUILDING AND RENAMING OF THE LIMESTONE PARKING GARAGE

<u>Recommendation</u>: that the Board of Trustees approve the naming of the new Winslow Street multi-use building The Cornerstone and approve the renaming of the adjacent Limestone Parking Garage as Cornerstone Garage.

<u>Background</u>: It was announced in March 2020 that per the results of a community wide vote involving current students, faculty, staff, alumni, and community members, the facility located at the corner of Winslow and South Limestone should be named "The Cornerstone," reflecting the building's role as a gateway to an emerging innovation district that will further connect the University and city. The project is scheduled to be completed in fall 2020.

Furthermore, the connected parking facility, including the existing Limestone parking structure as well as approximately 900 new parking spaces under construction is recommended to be named "Cornerstone Garage".

The food hall located on the ground floor of the structure, which has been named by the University's private retail partner "The Cornerstone Exchange", reinforces the distinct interconnected spaces soon to add vibrancy and activity to a key corner of the University of Kentucky's campus.

The Advisory Committee on Naming University Property has reviewed this request and found it to be in compliance with Administrative Regulation 9:5 and recommends approval of this name designation.
