Members, Board of Trustees:

PROPOSED REVISIONS TO THE GOVERNING REGULATIONS (SECOND READING)

Recommendation: that the Board of Trustees approve the following revisions to the Governing Regulations, which were received for preliminary consideration on April 29, 2022.

GR I – University Definition

- Update the name of College of Law to “J. David Rosenberg College of Law” in the definition of university
- Add Lewis Honors College to the definition of university
- Update Vision Statement to be consistent with the Strategic Vision Statement approved as part of the Strategic Plan
- Update title in Campus Sales section from “Director of Student Center” to “Executive Vice President for Finance and Administration”
- Eliminate section on Solicitation of Funds, which is no longer used or necessary
- Update GR format to current regulation style

GR II – Audit and Compliance Committee:

- Change “Chief Audit Executive” to “persons with responsibility for accountability and compliance” as the title has changed

GR IV – University Senate:

- Remove “Associate Provost for Undergraduate Education” from Senate Membership, as that position no longer exists
- Add Dean of Lewis Honors College to Senate Membership
- Correct titles that have changed, such as College of Agriculture, College of Communications and Information, and Faculty Advancement
- Update GR format to current regulation style

GR XI – Student Affairs:

- Change all references from Vice President for Student Affairs to “Vice President for Student Success”
- Update references to the documents entitled “Student Rights and Responsibilities” to *AR 4:10 Code of Student Conduct*
- Update GR format to current regulation style

In accordance with Governing Regulation XIII, the University Senate, Staff Senate, and Student Government Association have had an opportunity to review all amendments before final action by the Board of Trustees.
