UK HEALTHCARE FY2022
QUALITY, SAFETY AND PATIENT EXPERIENCE PLAN

Recommendation: that the Board of Trustees approve the UK HealthCare FY2022 Quality, Safety and Patient Experience Plan attached as Exhibit I.

Background: The University of Kentucky Governing Regulation II.E.i(1)(a), established the University Health Care Committee to serve as the governing body and governing authority to manage and operate the University Hospitals in accordance with the Conditions of Participation promulgated by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services and with the laws and regulations governing the operations and services of hospitals in the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

In 43 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 482, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) set out the conditions for a hospital to participate in the Medicare Program. As part of the conditions for participation, CMS requires in 42 CFR 482.21 that the participating hospital develop, implement, and maintain an effective, ongoing, hospital-wide, data-driven, quality assessment, and performance improvement program. The UK HealthCare FY2022 Quality, Safety and Patient Experience Plan sets out such a program for the University's hospitals and clinical activities for FY2022.

This Plan has been developed and approved by the necessary and appropriate officials as documented on page one of the attached Exhibit I.
